Notwithstanding the points of view held on the subject Clubs would know that the Executive has not introduced "a new rule" but has always had the power to deal with **unacceptable behaviour** and the sight of players tearing in from all over the ground to join in a "blue" is not only an eyesore and brings discredit to the game but is conduct which the Executive is anxious to "nip in the bud".

## A Section Review by Ross Booth



The A Section four is settled with **Ormond** and **Old Xaverians** meeting in the second semi-final and **Old Paradians & De La Salle** in the first semi-final.

But with this last round there is still a bit of interest down the table where **University Blues & Caulfield Grammarians** are fighting to stave off relegation.

**Blues** 18 point win over **Caulfield** following their 1 point defeat of **Old Xaverians** the week before puts **Caulfield** right in the hot seat. Both teams are level on 24 points but Blues percentage is much healthier. To avoid relegation Caulfield must beat De La Salle at Albert Park and rely on the Blues losing to North Old Boys at the University. Both results appear unlikely so it looks like Caulfield Grammarians and Bulleen-Templestowe for B Section.

It was the all important third quarter that made the difference in the **Caulfield-Blues** contest. Scores were level in the first half which was fairly dull apart from the report and send-off of 'Fields ruckman **David Matthews** - the second time this year! This helped keep the Blues in touch. But then came a 7 goal burst by the Blues including 3 goals in 3 minutes to Uni winger Al Christie and 2 goals to John Moloney, the ruck-roving son of former VCFL Chief Brian Moloney who was nervously watching from the side. Blues led by 46 points at three-quarter time and it was only 4 late goals which made Caulfield's score look respectable.

**Collegians** are safe from relegation after their 10 point win over **North Old Boys**. Lion ruckman **Peter King** changed the state of the game with 4 goals in the third quarter whilst "resting" in the pocket. North had a strong defence led by **Marcus Boyd** (CHB) and **Jerome Griffin** (FB) but struggled to kick goals. Lion Captain **Stuart Hinchin** played at full back with a hamstring worry and put in a creditable performance. These are the sorts of efforts that relegation can bring!

**De La Salle** beat **Old Paradians** by 8 goals at East Malvern. It was fairly close till ¾ time but DLS finished on with 5 goals and a string-of-behinds, whereas OP's were goalless. **Tim Cooke** had another great day in the centre and **Peter Rennie** bobbed up with 5 oals. This win gives DLS an important psychological boost for the first semi-final in a fortnight.

In the clash between top and bottom there were no fairy tales and **Ormond** crushed **Bulleen-Templestowe** by 114 points. The season cannot end soon enough for the Bullants. Their best naturally enough was a defender, back flanker **Simon Driver**. Congratulations to **Paul Lockhart** who played his 300th game for the Club. **Ormond's Paul Schukraft** found some form with some nice grabs and 7 goals for a season tally of 75 but **Phil Mehrten** sustained an injury thought to be ribs but he was sporting his arm in a sling at Elsternwick on Sunday watching **Old Xavs & Old Scotch**.

And what a game it was! The biggest Elsternwick crowd of the season possibly saw one of the best Games of the season. It certainly was fierce low-scoring mind you but very entertaining! "Family Football" at its best! Xavs were weakened by injury — **Nick Wilton, Nick Bourke, Steve Curtain, Paul Curtain** — and I thought at the last break with a 3 goal deficit that the dam might just burst and Scotch would get up. I thought so until **Scotch Captain Rob Fuller** was reported and sent off and that seemed to take all the sting out of Scotch and they lost by 17 points.

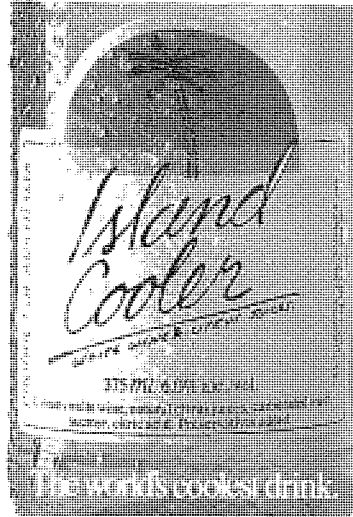

## Peter French Previews today's matches



Firstly, a brief look at last week. Bad luck **Old Brighton** whose 40 point win over Melbourne High was not enough to lift it back into 4th spot ahead of **Thomastown** on percentage, and well done **Old Haileybury** who returned to the winning list with a vengeance crushing **Hampton Rovers** by 69 points. It was not all bad news for the Rovers — **Ian Rice** informed his charges he would be an applicant for the coaching position again next season. **Balaclava** beat **AJAX** by 20 points in what must rate as one of the highest scoring matches in C Section as a total of 49 goals were scored. **AJAX** responded well to the challenge set at half time. Other winners were **Monash Blues** whose win over **Thomastown** will have done them no harm for Saturdays all important 2nd semi and **Kew**, predictably over **O.M.'s**, although Executive member **David Burns** advises that apart from **Kew's** sensational 11 goal second term **O.M.'s** outscored the "Browns" in 3 other quarters.

In B Section **Old Trinity** surprised with a vital win over **Ivanhoe**, a win which keeps "Trinners" in B Section for another season and **St. Bernards** 15 point win over **Marcellin** sees them deserved and outright leaders in the section and on performances throughout the year **St. Bernards** would now start as favourites for the flag and thus a return to A Section.

**Therry** grabbed the vital double chance with an impressive 62 point win over **Parkside** who sorely missed **Frank Sansonetti** and may well have lost the services of mercurial centreman **Mark Page**. Club President **Tom Johnston** was anxiously awaiting X ray results as the Club's A Section hopes have been dashed following back to back losses against **Marcellin & Therry**. As all who know him can imagine **Bernie Dunn** was "over the moon". Perhaps the presence of his former coach and mentor **Bernie Sheehy** did the trick for **Therry**?

**Uni Blacks** sent **St. Kilda CBC** back to C Section despite another brilliant solo effort from spearhead **Tony Riddell** who booted 10 goals (24 in a fortnight) and **Fawkner** gave its supporters great heart with a most convincing win over **Banyule**. As both Clubs face finalists in Parkside and Marcellin today their survival depends on performance and one can easily imagine the phone running hot at Pitcher Park and Bulleen.

**Old Paradians** stumbled badly at the Waverley Oval where **De La** recorded its second victory for the season against the Bundoora Boys and **Ormond** had little difficulty in accounting for **Bulleen-Templestowe**. **Collegians** restored its image somewhat with its 10 point victory over **North O.B. & Old Scotch** put up a strong and determined showing against **Old Xavs** failing in the end by 17 points due to some poor finishing. In the relegation battle **Uni Blues** brilliant third quarter proved too much for **Caulfield Grammarians** who now need a miracle to remain in A Section.

And so to today's games which close the minor round in A & B Section and mean mothballs for twelve clubs. The outstanding match of the round in A Section is at Elsternwick Park between **Old Paradians & Ormond**. It will be a good work out at headquarters for **Ormond** who must face the Xavs in a fortnight. I don't think Parade's form is down, but rather De La have hit their straps and are bound to leave a very big mark on the final series. **O.P.'s** are not unlike **Ormond** in their approach to the game and with little hanging on the game other than club pride and a place for certain players in semi final sides supporters can expect a high standard and first class game. As **Ormond** are currently more settled and may be better prepared I'm selecting them to finish on a high note with a win over the O.Ps.

**Bulleen-Templestowe** has a home game against **Old Scotch** to finish a season they will quickly want to forget. To have won only 1 game has been a bitter blow not only to the players but also to the clubs dedicated and loyal committee. Alas I cannot see them finishing the season with a win as **Old Scotch** have seen a good touch in the past month and will be most anxious to win this one for **Don Davenport** who has built up a close relationship with this Scotch team. They have some exciting players who are sure to make their mark next season. In particular **Duncan McCall, Ed Allen, Steve Reddish** who really is in superb touch, **Scott McGill, Steve Spiers** and **Simon Bones**.

**Old Xaverians** are sure to be well tested by **Collegians** for whom 1987 is best forgotten. Pre-season I thought that the Lions were on the verge of a "Golden Era" such was their dominance in 1986. However the "fire" disappeared as did some top players and in the end the Lions have had to be content with a "middle of the road" season.

Although there is little riding on today's game I'm of the opinion that once the bell's rung and the games on, the side which is mentally on top will win the day. **Xavs** have a number of selection worries at present and will be glad of the chance to rest **Mark Summers**.

I'll bet **John O'Sullivan** will appreciate a rest too! **Nick Wilton & Steve Curtain** could well return and so too should **Nick Bourke**, a late withdrawal last week and **Martin Beattie** who suffered a broken nose in a training mishap! Nice to see **Scottie Dennison** answer the call on a wet and wintry Sunday morning to help the Reserves. **Trivia question:** When did Old Xaverians Reserves last compete in a final series? A slab of Fosters to the first correct entry.

**Collegians** have some show. **Richard Schober** is back to his best form and **Simon Williams** is appreciating the move from full back. **David Hoyle** is providing great on-ball drive and **Peter King** should hold sway in the ruck due to the absence of **Millard & Summers**. Across the centre **Greg Tregear's** battle with **Anthony Callan** promises to be a real highlight and recent newcomers to A Section football **Wayne Daley (Collegians) & D. Mehegan (Xavs)** can be expected to show out.

Although **Collegians** won by 7 points at Elsternwick Park way back on May 2nd today I'll go with the Red & Black to win narrowly.

**University Blues** can make its position safe in A Section by beating **North O.B.** at the Beaufort oval. North have had a disastrous second half of the season winning just 2 games and as Blues have so much more for which to play I'm selecting them to win their third game on end. North's defence led by **Marcus Boyd, Jerome Griffin, Wayne Hanley & Mauro Borcich** who has relished being placed in the back pocket will stand up to most Blues attacks, but its inability to convert has seen its major downfall and I can't see a new forward line appearing in the last game of the year to kick it to victory.

**Caulfield Grammarians** faces the daunting task of beating **De La Salle** to have any hope of remaining in the section. Anyone at Caulfield who believes that is living in nobby land as De La has found the form which could take it "all the way" there's an air of quiet confidence at East Malvern at present which is spreading throughout all sections of the club and will manifest itself in a big win for the D's this afternoon.

It's a pity for Caulfield as I believe they'll be a very strong outfit next season with the return of a number of players from injury and overseas.

In B Section **Old Trinity** are at home to **Uni Blacks** in what promises to be a very entertaining and even game, now that **Old Trinity** has ensured its position for 1988. I believe the visitors will finish just in front.

**St. Bernards** at home meet **St. Kilda CBC** whose 1988 fate has been sealed. This will be just the sort of game **Frank Melican** would wish for his side who face a weeks break before its next encounter. There will be plenty of respect shown the Visitors and **Mick O'Dea** will certainly have his hands full with the inform **Tony Riddell**. However in the end class will out and **St. Bernards** will win.

**Therry** travel to **Ivanhoe** knowing it must win to remain second. **Ivanhoe** was most disappointing last week and are bound to put in a big one today in front of its home crowd and to end the season on a high note. However **Therry** not only have more at stake they are simply a better team and will show that today.

Old and famous rivals **Fawker & Parkside** clash at Pitcher Park in a game which is vital to **Fawker**. They go knowing a win or narrow loss could keep them in B Section provided **Marcellin** defeat **Banyule** which at **Marcellin** and following last week's loss to **St. Bernards** it should do. **Fawker** meet **Parkside** at a vulnerable time and having won well there last season I'm tipping them to get up today.

The C Section semi finals promise to be two great games.

**Kew & Monash** meet at Benteleigh with a win each during the season and its the same story between **Thomastown & O.M's** who'll play at the Harry Trott.

I just have to go for **Kew** to beat **Monash**. The Benteleigh oval is not unlike Victoria Park which has proven such a goal field for **Matt Cavanagh, Mark McColl & Chris Haralambopoulos** during the season. Not only do **Kew** boast the best mosquito fleet in the Association in **Joey Busuttill, Mario Bria, Rocco Zerbi & Captain Coach Brett Burden** but its unsung defence led by **Adrian Jenkins, Nick Lever, Robert Love and Nigel Griffiths** has had the lowest score kicked against it during the season. **Jenkins** has the big task of minding **Monash** skipper **Peter Forbes & Griffiths** will need to be on the job against **Dave Wood**. **Monash** are certainly no pretenders. They are an even well balanced side who respond well to the coaching of **Brian Ford**. ### REVIEW OF MATCHES PLAYED AUGUST 15, 1987.

#### D SECTION (Round 18)

#### G SECTION (Preliminary Final)

#### H SECTION (Preliminary Final)

We congratulate you George on reaching this "milestone" and hope that you will continue to play good, consistent football for the T.F.C. You can do it — I'm sure!

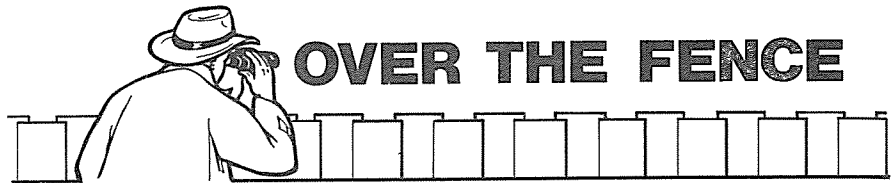
#### KEW OBITUARY
